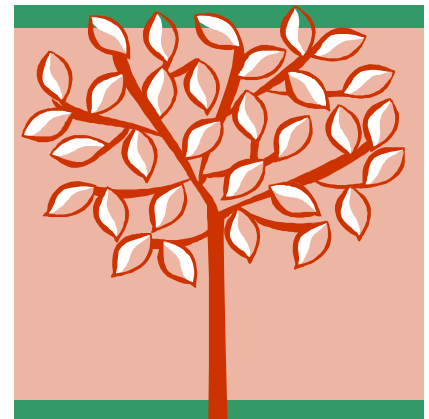

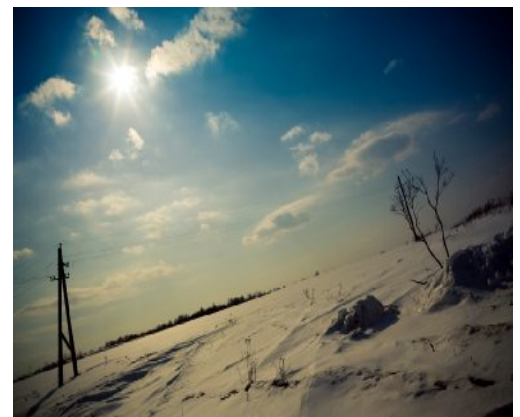
Places to enjoy in Sydney during Winter
