This edition of the July ROTA news hopefully finds you warm and well! Keep moving to keep warm—which is just what some members did on our tour of the Opera House in May.

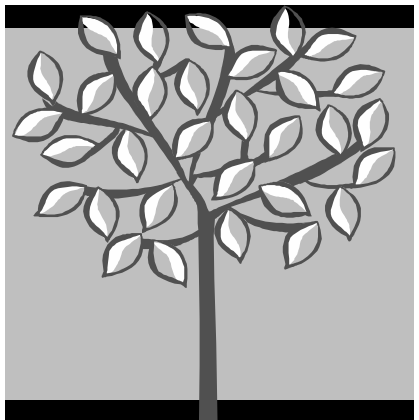

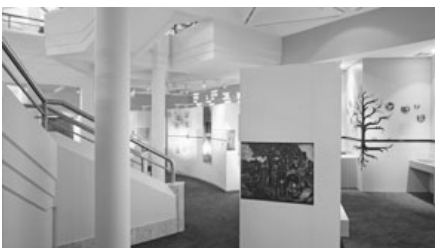

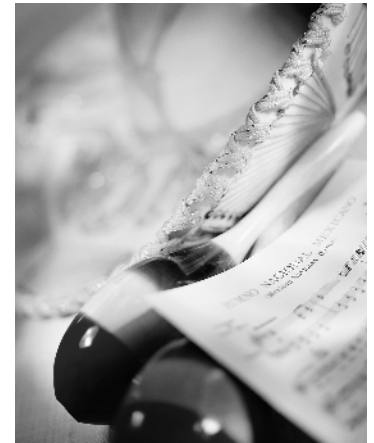
11.00am Jewish Museum, Darlinghurst
