Don't forget to note the outing dates in your diary and get your reply forms back in as soon as you can!

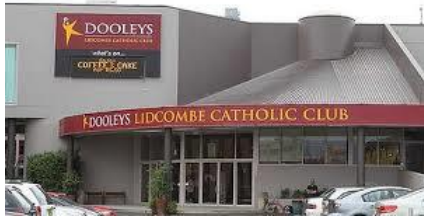
