Jamie Ryan, Partner, VJ Ryan & Company will update us on general financial compliance matters.



Darren Schutz has over 25 years' financial accounting experience initially as a Chartered Accountant with E&Y in their audit division. His roles have varied from financial accountant, to financial controller, to chief financial officer with entities ranging from smaller private family run businesses to large multinationals with US and Swiss origins. Now as CFO of the Institute of the Sisters of Mercy of Australia and Papua New Guinea, he is responsible for all things financial including the audit, statutory accounts, budgeting, treasury, investments, property valuations, fixed assets, payables, receivables, general ledger integrity, GST, PAYG, FBT, system maintenance and improvements i.e. responsible for the stewardship of the Institute's resources. Darren will address financial compliance from a congregation's point of view: how can a congregation ensure complete compliance and use that compliance to advantage the congregation's finances?



Peter Byrne has been in safety for many years across a variety of business and ministry sectors in both state based and national roles. For over 3 years now Peter has been the Work Health and Safety Advisor for the Institute of Sisters of Mercy of Australia and PNG. Peter manages and advises on WHS Management System, identification of hazards, risk mitigation, return to work coordination, contractor management, WHS training, emergency preparedness and response, safety auditing and Workers Compensation. Peter will address WHS compliance from a general and a congregational viewpoint.
