The Universe was born in intimacy, expanded into immensity, then incarnated into the intimacy of our home, Earth. Out of this intimacy has emerged all that we experience, all that we are. This 14 billion story is our new creation story, our new understanding of who we are, where we are, how we came to be, and what our role has been and must be within the greater community of Earth life. Our identity, our very beingness emerged over the last four billion years within the bounty and complexity of Earth.

During the three days of the seminar this Story will be presented as a vast sequence of gifts, freely given to all beings, out of which the great variety of Earth's forms and capacities, including our own, have evolved. The focus, however, will be to extend the great gift of the human, gratefulness, so that we might graciously continue to call Earth our home.



Larry Edwards has been teaching the Deep History of the Universe and its implications since the last century at the California Institute of Integral Studies (San Francisco, CA, USA), the University of Creation Spirituality (Oakland, CA, USA), Genesis Farm (Blairstown, NJ, USA), and the Dominican Ecocentre (Wicklow City, Co. Wicklow, Ireland). Larry earned his PH.D in Chemical-Physics from Harvard University. He has taught chemistry at several universities including the California Institute of Technology, the American University of Beirut, and California State University at Northridge and worked at the National Science Foundation for many years.
